Job Title: Lift Mechanic Crew Leader
Job Status: Year Round

Job Summary:

Responsible for the maintenance of the lift equipment, winter and summer. Assessment on a day-to-day basis to ensure that equipment is operating efficiently and safely.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Maintains and repairs lift equipment to ensure efficient, safe operations.
- Performs daily checks in winter at the direction of the Maintenance Supervisor.
- On instruction from the supervisor, checks assigned machinery locations in readiness for operation.
- Starting lift machinery, listening for abnormal sounds, examining all fluid levels, and maintaining daily log reports.
- Confirm at the end of the operational day that all lifts are turned off.
- Complete maintenance and repairs as required by Lift Maintenance Supervisor.
- Continually review daily logs recorded for repairs that are needed.
- Comfortable working at heights and frequently climbs towers in all weather conditions.
- Able to lift 50 – 100 lbs.
- Willing to wear the required PPE as necessary, i.e., hardhats, safety glasses, and fall restraint harness.
- Other duties as assigned by the supervisor could be directly related or unrelated to the original position.

Basic Requirements:

- Able to perform in severe and inclement weather conditions and terrain for sustained periods.
- Able to lift 50-100 lbs.
- Must have a US Driver's License.
- High School or equivalent.
